
TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: January 10, 2013
Summary of Decisions

1. **Ravi Sharma** (*Report No. 5641*)
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3477318.

DECISION:

The Tribunal revoked Ravi Sharma's taxicab driver's licence No. D01-3477318, effective immediately.

2. **Nurul Moral** (*Report No. 5783*)
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-2022757.

DECISION:

The Tribunal renewed Nurul Moral's taxicab driver's licence No. D01-2022757, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years;
- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Moral must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, updated abstracts of his driving and criminal record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Moral incurs any new tickets, charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act* or *Criminal Code of Canada* he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new tickets, charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5783, and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

3. **Estate of Bruce Edward Bell** (*Report No. 5991*)
James Bruce Bell, Trustee
Holder of Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-4203280, Plate No. 685.

DECISION:

The Tribunal extended taxicab owner's licence No. V02-4203280 for plate No. 685 in the Estate of Bruce Edward Bell for a period of twelve (12) months (up to December 14, 2013).

4. **Andrew Okungbowa-Ikponmwosa** (*Report No. 5565*)
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-2007293.

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Andrew Okungbowa-Ikponmwosa's taxicab driver's licence No D01-2007293 will be renewed, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be suspended until such time as proof is provided to Municipal Licensing and Standards that the mandatory requirement is removed from Mr. Okungbowa-Ikponmwosa's driver's licence;
- (2) immediately upon being reinstated, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years;
- (3) prior to the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Okungbowa-Ikponmwosa must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, updated abstracts of his driving and criminal records;
- (4) during the probationary period if Mr. Okungbowa-Ikponmwosa incurs any new tickets, charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act* or the *Criminal Code of Canada*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new tickets, charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5565, and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

5. **Arvinder Pal Singh Sabharwal** (*Report No. 5841*)
Holder of Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-3370366

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Arvinder Pal Singh Sabharwal's taxicab owner's licence No.V02-3370366, will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be suspended for five days;
- (2) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years from January 10, 2013;
- (3) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Sabharwal must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Mr. Sabharwal incurs any new tickets, charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards within three (3) business days; and
- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new tickets, charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5841 and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

6. **Bikramjit Singh Dhaliwal** (*Report No. 5096*)
Applicant for a Tow Truck Driver's Licence (Application No. A845753).

DECISION:

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to March 14, 2013.
(*Mr. Dhaliwal did not attend today's hearing.*)
