
TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: February 28, 2013
Summary of Decisions

1. **Ahmed Nawaz Khan** (*Report No. 5908*)
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3948809

DECISION:

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to April 4, 2013.
(*Mr. Khan failed to attend today's hearing.*)

2. **Farhad Moslemi** (*Report No. 6003*)
Applicant for a Taxicab Driver's (Lapsed) Licence (Application No. B200219).

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following pre-hearing agreement:

Farhad Moslemi's licence will be granted, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on February 28, 2013;
- (2) the licence will be immediately suspended until all outstanding fines are paid;
- (3) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Moslemi must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, updated abstracts of his driving record;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Mr. Moslemi incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act* or *Toronto Municipal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days;
- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 6003, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

The Tribunal ordered an amendment to the Pre-hearing Settlement: If, during the probationary period, the careless driving conviction is overturned and the charge is

dismissed, withdrawn or converted to a lesser charge, Municipal Licensing and Standards will agree to bring the matter back before the Tribunal for a hearing as to whether it is appropriate to modify the period of the probation.

3. **Mortaza Auto Clinic Inc.** (*Report No. 5988*)

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following pre-hearing agreement:

Mortaza Auto Clinic Inc's licence will be granted, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on February 28, 2013;
- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mortaza Auto Clinic Inc. must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at their own expense, an updated abstract of Mr. Alemi's criminal record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Alemi incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code* or *Criminal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5988, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

4. **Duane Joseph Alan Kent** (*Report No. 5962*)
Applicant for a Master Plumber's Licence (Application No. B200121)
Applicant for a Master Heating Installer's Licence (Application No. B200122).

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following pre-hearing agreement:

Duane Joseph Alan Kent's licences will be granted, effective immediately.

5. **Olusola J. Daramola** (*Report No. 5994*)

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following pre-hearing agreement:

Olusola J. Daramola's licence will be granted, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on February 28, 2013;
- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licences, Mr. Daramola must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Daramola incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code* or *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5994, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3608002.

DECISION:

The Tribunal granted Jason Anthony Azzopardi's application (No. B203606) for a tow truck driver's licence, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of four (4) years;
- (2) immediately upon being issued, Mr. Azzopardi must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, every 6 months, an updated abstract of his criminal record;
- (3) prior to each of the next four renewals, Mr. Azzopardi must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (4) immediately upon being issued, Mr. Azzopardi must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards immediately if Weston Auto Collision Ltd. does not employ him;
- (5) during the probationary period, Mr. Azzopardi must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, within 48 hours, in writing, of any change in his place or terms of employment;
- (6) during the probationary period, if Mr. Azzopardi incurs any new criminal charges or convictions or any charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, *Toronto Municipal Code* or *The Controlled Drug & Substances Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (7) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 6001, and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.
