**TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: March 21, 2013**

1. Enterprise Rent-a-Car Canada Ltd. (*Report No. 5668*)

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the following pre-hearing agreement:

Enterprise Rent-a-Car Canada Ltd.'s licences will be renewed and granted, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed and granted, the licences will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on March 21, 2013;
- (2) during the probationary period, if Enterprise Rent-a-Car Canada Ltd. incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code* they must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (3) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5668, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

2. **Nazaret Britsian** (*Report No. 5885*)  
Applicant for Renewal of Tow Truck Driver's Licence No. D09-3607450.

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Nazaret Britsian's application for renewal of tow truck driver's licence will be granted, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be suspended for a period of three (3) days, effective March 22, 2013;
- (2) immediately upon being reinstated, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of one (1) year minimum, or until proof is provided to Municipal Licensing and Standards that the December 3, 2012 conviction for careless driving is overturned. If proof is not provided, the probation period will be extended to three (3) years;
- (3) prior to each of the next three renewals, Mr. Britsian shall provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated driver's abstract;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Mr. Britsian incurs any charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5885, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

The Tribunal ordered Mr. Britsian to surrender his licence and photo card to Municipal Licensing and Standards.

**3. Navdeep Bajwa** (*Report No. 5922*)  
Applicant for a Taxicab Driver's Licence (Application No. B294670).

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Navdeep Bajwa's application (No. B294670) for a taxicab driver's licence will be granted, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of four (4) years;
- (2) every six months, Mr. Bajwa shall provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated driver's abstract;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Bajwa incurs any charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and

- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5922, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

4. **Jin Wen Zhou** (*Report No. 5861*)  
Holder of Holistic Practitioner Licence No. T30-3619045  
And  
Suiki Health Beauty Centre Inc.  
Holder of Holistic Owner Licence No. B30-4187982.

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal suspended Jin Wen Zhou's holistic practitioner's licence, effective immediately, pending the outcome of the criminal charges; and during the period of suspension, Mr. Zhou is not permitted to be alone with any patient while on his business premise.
