
TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: May 2, 2013
Summary of Decisions

1. **Leake Abraha Tesfai** (*Report No. 5927*)
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-3133455.

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following pre-hearing agreement:

Leake Abraha Tesfai's taxicab owner's licence will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Mr. Tesfai must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards proof of payment of all or any outstanding fines;
- (2) the licence will be suspended for a period of three (3) days;
- (3) immediately upon being reinstated, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on May 6, 2013;
- (4) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Tesfai must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (5) during the probationary period, if Mr. Tesfai incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code* or the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (6) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5927, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

With the consent of all parties, the Tribunal ordered an amendment to the wording in Item No. 1 of the Pre-hearing Settlement: Mr. Tesfai must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards proof of payment of all outstanding fines;

The Tribunal ordered Mr. Tesfai to surrender his plate, identification and photo card to Municipal Licensing and Standards on Friday, May 3, 2013.

2. **Edward Hau-Meng Su** (*Report No. 5932*)
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-3118762.

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following pre-hearing agreement:

Edward Hau-Meng Su's taxicab owner's licence will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Mr. Su must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards proof of payment of all or any outstanding fines;
- (2) the licence will be suspended for a period of five (5) days;
- (3) immediately upon being reinstated, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years;
- (4) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Su must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (5) during the probationary period, if Mr. Su incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code* or the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (6) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5932, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

With the consent of all parties, the Tribunal ordered an amendment to the wording in Item No. 1 of the Pre-hearing Settlement: Mr. Su must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards proof of payment of all outstanding fines;

Mr. Su is to surrender his plate and photo card to Municipal Licensing and Standards on Thursday, May 2, 2013.

3. **Estate of Audley J. Cuffe** (*Report No. 6048*)
Linda Cuffe, Executrix
Holder of Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-4298221, Taxicab Plate No. 2154.

DECISION:

The Tribunal extended taxicab owner's licence No. V02-4298221 for taxicab plate No. 2154 in the Estate of Audley J. Cuffe for a period of six (6) months to December 15, 2013.

4. **Estate of Chaim Turner** (*Report No. 6049*)
Emma Turner, Executrix
Holder of Taxicab Owner's Licence Nos. V02-4298405, V02-4298407 and V02-4298408, Taxicab Plate Nos. 600, 2492 and 3255.

DECISION:

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to May 30, 2013.

5. **Ghulam Mustafa Kamal** (*Report No. 5901*)
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3612242.

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Mr. Ghulam Mustafa Kamal's taxicab driver's licence will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on May 1, 2013;
- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Kamal must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his criminal record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Kamal incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Criminal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5901, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

6. **Maurice Francis Williams** (*Report No. 5900*)
Applicant for a Tow Truck Driver's Licence (Application No. B294129).

DECISION:

The Tribunal granted Maurice Francis Williams' application (No. B294129) for a tow truck driver's licence, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions.

- (1) immediately upon being issued, the license will be suspended until Mr. Williams provides to Municipal Licensing and Standards proof of payment of any outstanding fines;
- (2) immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of four (4) years;
- (3) during the probationary period, Mr. Williams must submit to Municipal Licensing and Standards every month a letter from his physician stating that:
 - i. he has attended the physician at his office;
 - ii. he reports having taken his prescribed medication as prescribed by the doctor;
 - iii. the physician sees no indication that would lead him to believe Mr. Williams could not drive in a manner that does not endanger the health and safety of the public.
- (4) prior to each of the next four renewals of the licence, Mr. Williams must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, updated abstracts of his criminal and driving records;
- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5900, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.
