**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

Imperial Parking Canada Corp.'s parking lot licences will be renewed and its applications for parking lot licences will be granted, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Imperial Parking Canada Corp. must provide to Municipal Licensing

and Standards proof of payment of any outstanding fines;

- (2) immediately upon being renewed, the licences will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years to commence on May 23, 2013;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Imperial Parking Canada Corp. incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code*, they must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5620, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

***With the consent of all parties, the Tribunal ordered an amendment to the wording in Item No. 2 of the Proposed Resolution: immediately upon being renewed, all licences referred to above will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years to commence on May 23, 2013. This is subject to any fines that may exist at the time the new licences are issued must be paid;***

The Tribunal approved the proposed resolution, ***as amended***.

## **2. Manouchehr Keshavarz** (Report No. 6060)

### **DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

Manouchehr Keshavarz' taxicab driver's licence will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Mr. Keshavarz must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards proof of payment of any outstanding fines;
- (2) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on May 23, 2013;
- (3) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Keshavarz must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Mr. Keshavarz incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code* or the

*Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and

- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 6060, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

2058440 Ontario Inc.'s public garage licence will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) 2058440 Ontario Inc. must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards proof of payment of any outstanding fines;
- (2) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years to commence on May 23, 2013;
- (3) prior to each of the next two renewals of the licence, Mr. Michele Minicucci must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his criminal record;
- (4) during the probationary period, if 2058440 Ontario Inc. and Mr. Michele Minicucci incur any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code* or the *Criminal Code*, they must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5940, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal renewed Elias Hassan Farah's taxicab driver's licence, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Mr. Farah must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards proof of payment of all outstanding fines;
- (2) the licence will be suspended for a period of fourteen (14) days, effective immediately and the suspension will continue until all outstanding fines are paid;
- (3) the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on May 23, 2013;
- (4) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Farah must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record and record of bylaw charges or convictions or *Liquor Licence Act* charges or convictions;
- (5) during the probationary period, if Mr. Farah incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code*, the *Highway Traffic Act* or the *Liquor Licence Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (6) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5919, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

The Tribunal ordered Mr. Farah to surrender his licence and photo card to Municipal Licensing and Standards by 4:00 p.m. today.
