
TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: June 6, 2013
Summary of Decisions

1. Abebe Gebreys (Report No. 5968)

Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3501484

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

Abebe Gebreys' taxicab driver's licence will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Mr. Gebreys must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards proof of payment of any outstanding fines;
- (2) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on June 6, 2013;
- (3) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Gebreys must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Mr. Gebreys incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code* or the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5968, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

2. Tiodolfo Gomez Infante (Report No. 5971)

Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3949463

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

Tiodolfo Gomez Infante's taxicab driver's licence will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Mr. Infante must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards proof of payment of any outstanding fines;
- (2) the licence will be suspended for a period of seven (7) days;
- (3) immediately upon being reinstated, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years;
- (4) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Infante must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (5) during the probationary period, if Mr. Infante incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code* or the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (6) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5971, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

The Tribunal ordered Mr. Infante to surrender his photo card and licence to Municipal Licensing and Standards on Friday, June 7, 2013. Mr. Infante will have the documents returned to him on Friday, June 13, 2013 at the same time he surrenders them on June 7.

3. Antoun T. Saleeb (Report No. 5952)

Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-2026473

And

Operating as Marina Auto Inc.

Applicant for Renewal of Public Garage Licence No. B68-3362501

DECISION:

The Tribunal renewed Antoun T. Saleeb's taxicab driver's licence and public garage licence, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on June 6, 2013;
- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Saleeb must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his criminal record;

- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Saleeb incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code* or the *Criminal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5952, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

4. Hamid Fard (Report No. 5980)
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3833351

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Hamid Fard's taxicab driver's licence will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Mr. Fard's taxicab driver's licence will be suspended for a period of seven (7) days commencing June 6, 2013;
- (2) immediately upon being reinstated, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years;
- (3) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Fard must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Mr. Fard incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5980, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

The Tribunal ordered Hamid Fard to surrender his photo card and licence to Municipal Licensing and Standards today.

- 5. Mubarak Ali Khan** (Report No. 5954)
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-3242504

DECISION:

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to December 12, 2013. Mr. Khan's taxicab driving privileges will be suspended in the interim.

- 6. Philips M. Udofe** (Report No. 5580)
Holder of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3253431

DECISION:

The Tribunal placed the following conditions on Philips M. Udofe's taxicab driver's licence:

- (1) the licence will be suspended for a period of ten (10) days;
- (2) immediately upon being reinstated, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years;
- (3) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Udofe must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, updated abstracts of his driving record and criminal record;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Mr. Udofe incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code*, the *Highway Traffic Act* or the *Criminal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5580, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.
