**TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: June 20, 2013**  
**Summary of Decisions**

- 1. BD Canada Ltd.** (Report No. 5984)  
o/a Cobs Bread  
Applicant for Renewal of Retail Store (Food) Licence No. B50-4075942  
AND  
Holder of Retail Store (Food) Licence Nos. B50-3845545 and B50-3950954

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

BD Canada Ltd.'s retail store (food) licences will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) BD Canada Ltd. must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards proof of payment of any outstanding fines;
- (2) immediately upon being renewed, the licences will be placed on probation for a period of one year to commence on June 20, 2013;
- (3) during the probationary period, if BD Canada Ltd. incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code*, they must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5984, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

***With the consent of all parties, the Tribunal ordered two amendments to the proposed resolution as follows:***

- (i) ***The last line in the subject should read: Holder of Retail Store (Food) Licence Nos. B50-3845545 and B50-3950954;***
- (ii) ***BD Canada Ltd. agrees to comply with all requirements of the Toronto Municipal Code.***

The Tribunal approved the proposed resolution, **as amended**.

**2. Jonathan Allan Robert Vanattan** (Report No. 5942)  
Applicant for Renewal of Tow Truck Driver's Licence No. D09-3616362

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

Jonathan Allan Robert Vanattan's licence will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Mr. Vanattan must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards proof of payment of any outstanding fines;
- (2) Mr. Vanattan's licence shall be immediately suspended for a period of three (3) days, to commence on June 21, 2013 and the Applicant must surrender his tow truck driver's licence on that day;
- (3) immediately upon being reinstated, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on June 20, 2013;
- (4) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Vanattan must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (5) during the probationary period, if Mr. Vanattan incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code* or the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (6) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5942, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

***The Tribunal ordered an amendment to the wording in Item No. 2 of the Proposed Resolution: Mr. Vanattan's licence shall be immediately suspended for a period of three (3) days effective June 21, 2013 and the Applicant must surrender his tow truck driver's licence and four (4) plates on that date at 8:30 a.m.***

The Tribunal approved the proposed resolution, **as amended**.

**3. Muhammad Ahmad Iqbal** (Report No. 5986)  
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3953893

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

Muhammad Ahmad Iqbal's taxicab driver's licence will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Mr. Iqbal must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards proof of payment of any outstanding fines;
- (2) Mr. Iqbal's licence shall be suspended for a period of five (5) days effective June 20, 2013; he must surrender his taxicab licence and photo card to Municipal Licensing and Standards today;
- (3) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on June 20, 2013;
- (4) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Iqbal must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his criminal and driving records;
- (5) during the probationary period, if Mr. Iqbal incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code*, the *Highway Traffic Act* or the *Criminal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (6) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5986, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

The Tribunal ordered Muhammad Ahmad Iqbal to surrender his photo card and licence to Municipal Licensing and Standards forthwith.

**4. Mustafa Qamar** (Report No. 6067)  
Applicant for Taxicab Driver's (Lapsed) Licence (Application No. B305809)

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

Mustafa Qamar's taxicab driver's licence will be issued, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Mr. Qamar must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards proof of payment of any outstanding fines;
- (2) immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years to commence on June 20, 2013;
- (3) prior to each of the next two renewals of the licence, Mr. Qamar must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his criminal record;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Mr. Qamar incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Criminal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 6067, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

**5. Syed Muhammad Zaidi (Report No. 5981)**

Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3958494

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

Syed Muhammad Zaidi's taxicab driver's licence will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Mr. Zaidi must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards proof of payment of any outstanding fines;
- (2) Mr. Zaidi's licence shall be suspended for a period of three (3) days to commence on June 21, 2013; he must surrender his licence and photo card to Municipal Licensing and Standards on that date;
- (3) immediately upon being renewed the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on June 20, 2013;
- (4) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Zaidi must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (5) during the probation period, if Mr. Zaidi incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal

Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and

- (6) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5981, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

The Tribunal ordered Syed Muhammad Zaidi to surrender his photo card and licence to Municipal Licensing and Standards on Friday, June 21, 2013 at 8:30 a.m.

**6. Mohammed Ali Mir (Report No. 5969)**  
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-2026574

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

Mohammed Ali Mir's taxicab driver's licence will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Mr. Mir must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards proof of payment of any outstanding fines;
- (2) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years to commence on June 20, 2013;
- (3) prior to each of the next two renewals of the licence, Mr. Mir must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his criminal record;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Mr. Mir incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Criminal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5969, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

**7. Manish Kumar Kamal (Report No. 6064)**  
Applicant for a Taxicab Driver's Licence (Application No. B303833)

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

Manish Kumar Kamal's taxicab driver's licence will be issued, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Mr. Kamal must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards proof of payment of any outstanding fines;
- (2) immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years to commence on June 20, 2013;
- (3) prior to each of the next two renewals of the licence, Mr. Kamal must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his criminal record;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Mr. Kamal incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code* or the *Criminal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 6064, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

**8. Tarminder Singh (Report No. 5868)**  
Holder of Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-4062644

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

Tarminder Singh's taxicab owner's licence will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Mr. Singh must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards proof of payment of any outstanding fines;
- (2) Mr. Singh's licence shall be immediately suspended for a period of ten (10) days, to commence on June 20, 2013 and the Applicant must surrender his taxicab licence, photo card and owner's plate to Municipal Licensing and Standards today;
- (3) immediately upon being reinstated, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on June 20, 2013;

- (4) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Singh must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his criminal and driving records;
- (5) during the probationary period, if Mr. Singh incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code*, the *Criminal Code* or the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (6) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5868, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

**9. Tony Orangis** (Report No. 5859)

Applicant for a Tow Truck Driver's Licence (Application No. B180725)

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

Tony Orangis' application for a tow truck driver's licence will be granted, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Mr. Orangis must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards proof of payment of any outstanding fines;
- (2) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on June 20, 2013;
- (3) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Orangis must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, updated abstracts of his criminal and driving records;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Mr. Orangis incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code*, the *Compulsory Automobile Insurance Act*, the *Criminal Code* or the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5859, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

***With the consent of all parties, the Tribunal ordered two amendments to***

***the proposed resolution as follows:***

- 1. By July 31, 2013 Mr. Orangis must provide proof to Municipal Licensing and Standards that he has been granted an extension to pay outstanding fines for by-law offences incurred on Sept 10, 1999 and December 8, 1997.***
  
- ii. Prior to each of the next 3 renewals of the licence, Mr. Orangis must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, updated abstracts of his criminal and driving records; and proof of regular payment of outstanding fines incurred as of June 20, 2013;***

**10. Tehseen Perweez Mir (Report No. 6023)**

Holder of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-4075524

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to October 10, 2013 as Mr. Mir's counsel was not available on today's date.
