**TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: June 27, 2013**  
**Summary of Decisions**

**1. Waqas Younis** (Report No. 5934)

Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3949398

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

Waqas Younis' licence will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Mr. Younis must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards proof of payment of any outstanding fines;
- (2) Mr. Younis' licence shall be suspended for a period of four (4) days, commencing on July 2, 2013 to end of day July 5, 2013; and the applicant must surrender his licence and photo card on July 2<sup>nd</sup>;
- (3) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on June 27, 2013;
- (4) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Younis must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (5) during the probationary period, if Mr. Younis incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code* or the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (6) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5934, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

**2. Andre Gray** (Report No. 5707)  
Holder of Tow Truck Driver's Licence No. D09-3845131

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

Andre Gray's tow truck driver's licence will be reinstated and renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being reinstated and renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of four (4) years to commence on June 27, 2013;
- (2) prior to end of the probation period, Mr. Gray may file with Municipal Licensing and Standards proof of the 2012 criminal charges having been withdrawn, stayed, or resolved on the basis of a final judgement of not guilty (i.e. after the appeal period has passed or any appeals have been finally determined). Upon the filing of such proof, the probation period shall be reduced from 4 years to 3 years, but shall not be reduced to any period less than 3 years, from June 27, 2013;
- (3) prior to December 20, 2013, Mr. Gray shall provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, updated abstracts of his driver's and criminal records. To ensure they are up to date, both the driver's abstract and criminal record report must post-day November 30, 2013 (i.e. the reports must have been generated or dated after November 30, 2013);
- (4) after December 15, 2013, prior to each of the next 4 renewals deadlines attaching to the licence, Mr. Gray shall provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, updated driver's abstract and criminal record. To ensure they are up to date, both the driver's abstract and criminal record report must have been generated or dated within 30 days prior to the renewal date;
- (5) during the probationary period, if Mr. Gray incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code*, the *Criminal Code* or the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (6) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5707, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.
