
TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: July 18, 2013
Summary of Decisions

- 1. Ahmed Nawaz Khan** (Report No. 5908)
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3948809

DECISION:

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to December 5, 2013 and ordered that Mr. Khan's taxicab driver's licence will be suspended in the interim. If the outstanding fine is paid, Mr. Khan can request an earlier hearing date.

(Mr. Khan failed to attend today's hearing).

- 2. Cloke-Kirby Construction Ltd.** (Report No. 6058)

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

Cloke-Kirby Construction Ltd.'s licence will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Cloke-Kirby Construction Ltd. must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards proof of payment of any outstanding by-law fines before the date of the hearing, failing which the licence will be suspended until proof of payment of any outstanding fines is filed;
- (2) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on July 18, 2013;
- (3) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Carter must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his criminal record;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Cloke-Kirby Construction Ltd. or Mr. Carter incur any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto*

Municipal Code or the *Criminal Code*, they must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and

- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 6058, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

3. Zohaib Chaudhry (Report No. 6080)

Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3946891

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

Zohaib Chaudhry's licence will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Zohaib Chaudhry's licence shall be suspended for a period of four (4) days to commence on July 18, 2013; he must surrender his licence and photo card to Municipal Licensing and Standards on that date;
- (2) Mr. Chaudhry must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards proof of payment of any outstanding by-law fines before the date of the hearing, failing which the licence will be suspended until proof of payment of any outstanding fines is filed;
- (3) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three years to commence on July 18, 2013;
- (4) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Chaudhry must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, updated abstracts of his driving and criminal records;
- (5) during the probationary period, if Mr. Chaudhry incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code*, the *Highway Traffic Act* or the *Criminal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (6) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 6080, and any updating material, shall be brought back

before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

The Tribunal ordered Mr. Chaudhry to surrender his licence and photo card to Municipal Licensing and Standards immediately.

4. Crystal Amy Hofmans (Report No. 6089)
Applicant for a Body Rubber's Licence (Application No. B309699)

DECISION:

Crystal Amy Hofmans' licence will be issued, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years to commence on July 18, 2013;
- (2) prior to each of the next two renewals of the licence, Ms. Hofmans must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at her own expense, an updated abstract of her criminal record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Ms. Hofmans incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code* or the *Criminal Code*, she must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 6089, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

5. Morgan Otuo Acheampong (Report No. 5996)
Holder of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3121821

DECISION:

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to July 25, 2013.

6. Mohammad Reza Hosseinioun (Report No. 6074)
Holder of Ambassador Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-3588399]

DECISION:

July 18, 2013

The Tribunal placed the following conditions on Mohammad Reza Hosseinioun's Ambassador taxicab owner's licence:

- (1) the licence will be suspended for a period of three (3) days to commence on July 19, 2013;
- (2) immediately upon being reinstated, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years commencing July 18, 2013;
- (3) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Hosseinioun must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Mr. Hosseinioun incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code* or the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 6074, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

The Tribunal ordered Mr. Hosseinioun to surrender his Ambassador owner's plate and photo card to Municipal Licensing and Standards on Friday, July 19, 2013.
