
TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: August 1, 2013
Summary of Decisions

1. Estate of Walter Rafael Tabarez (Report No. 6095)

Christine Tabarez, Executrix

Holder of Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-4200913, for Taxicab Plate No. 3237

DECISION:

The Tribunal extended taxicab owner's licence No. V02-4200913 for taxicab plate No. 3237 in the Estate of Walter Rafael Tabarez for a period of eight months to April 28th, 2014 without prejudice for the parties to reapply on that date for a further extension, if required.

2. Gerald Nelson Jackson (Report No. 5990)

Holder of Building Renovator's Licence No. T85-3723501

DECISION:

The Tribunal revoked Gerald Nelson Jackson's building renovator's licence No. T85-3723501, effective immediately.

(Mr. Jackson failed to attend today's hearing).

3. Milkha Grewal (Report No. 5963)

Applicant for a Taxicab Driver's (Lapsed) Licence (Application No. B299718)

DECISION:

The Tribunal denied Milkha Grewal's application (No. B299718) for a taxicab driver's licence.

4. Niruban Theyagarajah (Report No. 6092)
Applicant for a Tow Truck Driver's Licence (Application No. B310252)

DECISION:

The Tribunal granted Niruban Theyagarajah's application for a tow truck driver's licence, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of 3 years to commence on August 1, 2013;
- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Theyagarajah must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his criminal record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Theyagarajah incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code* or the *Criminal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within five (5) business days which can be done in the following ways:
 - in person at 850 Coxwell Avenue, Toronto, ON M4C 5R1
 - via regular mail to: 850 Coxwell Avenue, Toronto, ON M4C 5R1
 - via e-mail to mlsconditionreporting@toronto.ca; or
 - via fax at 416-392-3102; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 6092, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

5. Sanusi Alhassan (Report No. 6007)
Applicant for a Taxicab Driver's Licence (Application No. B299057)

DECISION:

The Tribunal granted Sanusi Alhassan's application for a taxicab driver's licence, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being granted, the licence will be suspended for 15 days, effective August 1, 2013.
- (2) the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three years, to commence on August 1, 2013;

- (3) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Alhassan must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Mr. Alhassan incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code* or the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days:
 - in person at 850 Coxwell Avenue, Toronto, ON M4C 5R1
 - via regular mail to: 850 Coxwell Avenue, Toronto, ON M4C 5R1
 - via e-mail to mlsconditionreporting@toronto.ca; or
 - via fax at 416-392-3102; and
- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 6007, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

6. Morgan Otuo Acheampong (Report No. 5996)
Holder of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3121821

DECISION:

The Tribunal renewed Morgan Otuo Acheampong's taxicab driver's licence effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of five years to commence on August 1, 2013;
- (2) prior to each of the next five renewals of the licence, Mr. Acheampong must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Acheampong incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code* or the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days:
 - in person at 850 Coxwell Avenue, Toronto, ON M4C 5R1
 - via regular mail to: 850 Coxwell Avenue, Toronto, ON M4C 5R1
 - via e-mail to mlsconditionreporting@toronto.ca; or
 - via fax at 416-392-3102; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and

report No. 5996, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

7. Satgunanathan Thillainathan (Report No. 6015)
Applicant for Renewal of Driving Instructor's Licence No. V11-4188344

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

Satgunanathan Thillainathan's driving instructor's licence will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Mr. Thillainathan's licence shall be immediately suspended for a period of six (6) days commencing August 1, 2013 and he must surrender his driving instructor's licence and photo card today;
- (2) Mr. Thillainathan must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards proof of payment of any outstanding by-law fines before the date of the hearing, failing which the licence will be suspended until proof of payment of any outstanding fines is filed;
- (3) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on August 1, 2013;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Mr. Thillainathan incurs any new charges or convictions under *Toronto Municipal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 6015, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

The Tribunal ordered an amendment to the proposed resolution as follows:

- (i) ***Condition No. 2 is to be removed.***
