#### **DECISION:**

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licences will be placed on probation for a period of one (1) year to commence on August 29, 2013;
- (2) during the probationary period, if Electronics Boutique Canada Inc. incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code*, they must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within fifteen (15) business days, which can be done in the following ways:
