
TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: September 5, 2013

- 1. Abduljawad Ibrahim Sharif** (Report No. 6056)
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-3240524

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

Abduljawad Ibrahim Sharif's taxicab owner's licence will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of 1 (one) year to commence on September 5, 2013;
- (2) prior to each of the next one renewal of the licence, Mr. Sharif must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Sharif incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code* or the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days which can be done in the following ways:

2. Joshua Glenn Gordon Porter (Report No. 6096)
o/a GTA's Finest Roofing
Applicant for a Building Renovator's Licence (Application No. B308095)

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

Joshua Glenn Gordon Porter's building renovator's licence will be granted, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years to commence on September 5, 2013;
- (2) prior to each of the next two renewals of the licence, Mr. Porter must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his criminal record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Porter incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code* or the *Criminal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days which can be done in the following ways:

3. Manjit Singh Chhokar (Report No. 6044)
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3607643

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

Manjit Singh Chhokar's taxicab driver's licence will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on September 5, 2013;

- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Chhokar must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Chhokar incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code* or the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days which can be done in the following ways:

4. Asim Parvez (Report No. 6016)

Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3958860

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

Asim Parvez' taxicab driver's licence will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence shall be immediately suspended for a period of four (4) days to commence on September 5, 2013. Mr. Parvez must surrender his taxicab driver's licence and photo card on that date;
- (2) Mr. Parvez must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards proof of payment of any outstanding by-law fines before the date of the hearing, failing which the licence will be suspended until proof of payment of any outstanding fines is filed;
- (3) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on September 5, 2013;

- (4) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Parvez must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (5) during the probationary period, if Mr. Parvez incurs any new charges or convictions under the Toronto Municipal Code or the Highway Traffic Act, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days which can be done in the following ways:
