**TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: September 19, 2013**  
**Summary of Decisions**

**1. Estate of Gus Kubitschek (Report No. 6120)**

Walter Kubitschek - Executor

Holder of Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-4202280 for Taxicab Plate No. 1416

DECISION:

The Tribunal extended taxicab owner's licence No. V02-4202280 for taxicab plate No. 1416 in the Estate of Gus Kubitschek for a period of eight months, from October 31, 2013 to June 30, 2014.

**2. Allahditta Sheikh (Report No. 6018)**

Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-2016622

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

Allahditta Sheikh's taxicab driver's licence will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Upon returning to Canada, the Applicant's licence shall be immediately suspended for a period of two (2) days. Mr. Sheikh must surrender his taxicab driver's licence and photo card on that date;
- (2) Mr. Sheikh must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards proof of payment of any outstanding by-law fines before the date of the hearing, failing which the licence will be suspended until proof of payment of any outstanding fines is filed;
- (3) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of two years to commence on September 19, 2013;
- (4) prior to each of the next two renewals of the licence, Mr. Sheikh must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;

(5) during the probationary period, if Mr. Sheikh incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code* or the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days, which can be done in the following ways:

- in person at 850 Coxwell Avenue, Toronto, ON M4C 5R1
- via regular mail to: 850 Coxwell Avenue, Toronto, ON M4C 5R1
- via e-mail to [mlsconditionreporting@toronto.ca](mailto:mlsconditionreporting@toronto.ca); or
- via fax at 416-392-3102

(6) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 6018, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

***The Tribunal ordered amendments to the proposed resolution as follows:***

***i. Condition No. 1 should read as follows:***

***Upon returning to Canada, the Applicant's licence shall be immediately suspended for a period of two (2) days and the Applicant must surrender his taxicab driver's licence and photo card on the day he returns.***

***ii. Condition No. 2 to be removed.***

***iii. Bolded paragraph on page 2 regarding outstanding by-law fines to be removed.***

- 3. Daniel Michael** (Report No. 6094)  
Applicant for a Limousine Driver's Licence (Application No. B308364)

DECISION:

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to October 31, 2013.

- 4. Mudasar Ali Chandiwala** (Report No. 6057)  
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3834641

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

Mudasar Ali Chandiwala's taxicab driver's licence will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) the licence shall be immediately suspended for a period of three (3) days to commence on September 19, 2013. Mr. Chandiwala must surrender his taxicab driver's licence and photo card on that date;
- (2) Mr. Chandiwala must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards proof of payment of any outstanding by-law fines before the date of the hearing, failing which the licence will be suspended until proof of payment of any outstanding fines is filed;
- (3) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three years to commence on September 19, 2013;
- (4) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Chandiwala must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, updated abstracts of his criminal driving records;
- (5) during the probationary period, if Mr. Chandiwala incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code*, the *Criminal Code* or the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days which can be done in the following ways:
  - in person at 850 Coxwell Avenue, Toronto, ON M4C 5R1
  - via regular mail to: 850 Coxwell Avenue, Toronto, ON M4C 5R1
  - via e-mail to [mlsconditionreporting@toronto.ca](mailto:mlsconditionreporting@toronto.ca); or
  - via fax at 416-392-3102
- (6) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 6057, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

***The Tribunal ordered amendments to the proposed resolution as follows:***

- i. Condition No. 2 to be removed.***
- ii. Bolded paragraph on page 2 regarding outstanding by-law fines to be removed.***
- iii. In Condition No. 4, the word 'and' should be inserted between criminal driving.***
- iv. In Condition No. 5, the word 'or' should be replaced with the word 'and' between Criminal Code or the Highway Traffic Act.***

**5. Jennifer Leigh Harrison (Report No. 6099)**  
Applicant for a Holistic Practitioner's Licence (Application No. B310996)

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Jennifer Leigh Harrison's application for a holistic practitioner's licence will be granted, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) On March 16, 2014 and every six (6) months thereafter, Ms. Harrison shall provide to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards proof that she has paid at minimum \$100.00 per month toward her outstanding by-law conviction fines.
- (2) Should Ms. Harrison fail to provide the proof of payment as required, report No. 6099, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for another hearing.

***The Tribunal ordered an amendment to the joint settlement as follows:***

- i. In Condition No. 1, after \$100.00 per month, the wording 'beginning October 1, 2013' should be inserted.***

**6. Dawit Habte Fikremichael (Report No. 6006)**  
Applicant for a Taxicab Driver's Licence (Application No. B203535)

DECISION:

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to October 3, 2013.
