1. Harjap Singh Dehar (Report No. 6105)

Holder of Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-3604145 for Taxicab Plate No. 3210

DECISION:

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to November 21, 2013, *peremptory* to all parties.

2. Yadwinder Singh Pannu (Report No. 6106)

Holder of Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-3484254 for Taxicab Plate No. 410; and Agent for Taxicab Plate Nos. 623, 1403 and 3210

DECISION:

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to November 21, 2013, *peremptory* to all parties.

3. Zia Jalil Uddin Ahmed (Report No. 5606)

Holder of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3837445

DECISION:

The Tribunal revoked Zia Jalil Uddin Ahmed's taxicab driver's licence effective immediately.

4. Shahrar Husain Mirza (Report No. 6108)

Applicant for a Taxicab Driver's Licence (Application No. B307310)

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

Shahran Husain Mirza's taxicab driver's licence will be issued, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Shahran Husain Mirza must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards proof of payment of any outstanding by-law fines before the date of the hearing, failing which the licence will be suspended until proof of payment of any outstanding fines is filed;
- (2) immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years to commence on September 26, 2013;
- (3) prior to each of the next two renewals of the licence, Mr. Mirza must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his criminal record;

5. Wessen Tolla Gebresilassie (Report No. 6103)
Holder of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3250760

DECISION:
