1. Estate of Jack Silverberg (Report No. 6104)

DECISION:

The Tribunal extended taxicab owner's licence Nos. V02-4201786 and V02-4201787 for taxicab plate Nos. 571 and 2715 in the Estate of Jack Silverberg for a period of six (6) months to April 3, 2014.

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following joint proposed resolution:

1487330 Ontario Inc.'s motorized refreshment vehicle licences will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) the licences will be suspended for a period of three (3) days commencing October 4, 2013, and all five licence plates and Ms. Mantis' photo card must be surrendered to Municipal Licensing and Standards on that date;
- (2) immediately upon being renewed, the licences will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years to commence on October 3, 2013;
- (3) during the probationary period, if 1487330 Ontario Inc. or Ms. Mantis incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code* or the *Highway Traffic Act*, they must be reported to Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within five (5) business days which can be done in the following ways:

 - via regular mail to: 850 Coxwell Ave, Toronto, Ontario M4C 5R1
 - via email to mlsconditionreporting@toronto.ca; or
 - via fax at 416-392-3102
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 6078, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

DECISION:

The Tribunal placed the following conditions on 1710324 Ontario Inc.'s tow truck owner's licences and public garage licence:
