DECISION:

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

2206422 Ontario Ltd.'s eating establishment licence will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) 2206422 Ontario Ltd. must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards proof of payment of any outstanding by-law fines before the date of the hearing, failing which the licence will be suspended until proof of payment of any outstanding fines is filed;
- (2) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of one (1) year to commence on October 10, 2013;
- (3) during the probationary period, if 2206422 Ontario Ltd. incur any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code*, they must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days which can be done in the following ways:

- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 6061, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

3. Imran Malik (Report No. 6030)

Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3599786

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

Imran Malik's taxicab driver's licence will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Imran Malik's licence shall be immediately suspended for a period of four (4) days commencing October 10, 2013 and Mr. Malik must surrender his taxicab driver's licence and photo card on that date;
- (2) Mr. Malik must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards proof of payment of any outstanding by-law fines before the date of the hearing, failing which the licence will be suspended until proof of payment of any outstanding fines is filed;
- (3) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on October 10, 2013;
- (4) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Malik must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (5) during the probationary period, if Mr. Malik incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code* or the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days which can be done in the following ways:
 - in person at 850 Coxwell Ave, Toronto, Ontario M4C 5R1
 - via regular mail to: 850 Coxwell Ave, Toronto, Ontario M4C 5R1
 - via email to mlsconditionreporting@toronto.ca; or
 - via fax at 416-392-3102
- (6) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 6030, and any updating material, shall be brought back

before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

With the consent of all parties, the Tribunal ordered three amendments to the Proposed Resolution as follows:

- i. Condition No. 2 is to be removed***
- ii. Bolded paragraph on page 2 regarding outstanding by-law fines is to be removed***
- iii. If Mr. Malik is unable to find his photo card when the suspension begins, he is required to go to the Municipal Licensing and Standards office and swear an affidavit that he does not have his photo card in his possession.***

The Tribunal approved the proposed resolution, ***as amended.***

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

Grate Drain of Ontario Ltd.'s licence will be issued, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years to commence on October 10, 2013;
- (2) prior to each of the next two renewals of the licence, Grate Drain of Ontario Ltd. and Mr. Whittaker must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at their own expense, an updated abstract of their criminal record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Grate Drain of Ontario Ltd. or Mr. Whittaker incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code* or the *Criminal Code*, they must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days which can be done in the following ways:
