
TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: October 17, 2013

1. **Ravi Sharma** (Report No. 6091)
Applicant for a Taxicab Driver's Licence (Application No. B307144)

DECISION:

The Tribunal denied Ravi Sharma's application (No. B307144) for a taxicab driver's licence.

2. **Syed Shaukat Ali** (Report No. 6076)
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3592387

DECISION:

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to November 21, 2013.

3. **Mubshar Mahmood** (Report No. 6025)
Holder of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3354998

DECISION:

Tribunal adjourned this matter to December 5, 2013, on consent.

If Mr. Mahmood is required to leave the country to attend to personal matters before December 5th, 2013 he must provide proof to Municipal Licensing and Standards of his flight plans before leaving. If such proof is supplied, on December 5th, 2013 the City will then ask the Tribunal to adjourn the matter to March 13, 2014.

- 4. Carlos A. Hidalgo** (Report No. 6118)
o/a Uptown Plumbing
Applicant for a Plumbing Contractor's Licence (Application No. B311552)
AND
Applicant for a Master Plumber Licence (Application No. B311546)

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

Carlos A. Hidalgo's application for a plumbing contractor's licence and master plumber's licence will be granted, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Carlos A. Hidalgo must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards proof of payment of any outstanding by-law fines before the date of the hearing, failing which the licence will be suspended until proof of payment of any outstanding fines is filed;
- (2) immediately upon being issued, the licences will be placed on probation for a period of four (4) years to commence on October 17, 2013;
- (3) prior to each of the next four renewals of the licence, Mr. Hidalgo must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his criminal record;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Mr. Hidalgo incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code* or the *Criminal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days which can be done in the following ways:
 - in person at 850 Coxwell Ave., Toronto, Ontario M4C 5R1
 - via regular mail to: 850 Coxwell Ave., Toronto, Ontario M4C 5R1
 - via email to milsconditionreporting@toronto.ca; or
 - via fax at 416-392-3102
- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 6118, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

With the consent of all parties, the Tribunal ordered two amendments to the Proposed Resolution as follows:

- i. Condition No. 1 is to be removed***

ii. Bolded paragraph on page 2 regarding outstanding by-law fines is to be removed

5. Arif Saleem (Report No. 5791)

Applicant for Renewal of Tow Truck Driver's Licence No. D09-4073890

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

Arif Saleem's tow truck driver's licence will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) the licence shall be immediately suspended for a period of eight (8) days to commence on October 17, 2013 and Mr. Saleem must surrender his tow truck driver's licence on that date;
- (2) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on October 17, 2013;
- (3) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Saleem must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, updated abstracts of his criminal and driving records;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Mr. Saleem incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code*, the *Highway Traffic Act* or the *Criminal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days which can be done in the following ways:
 - in person at 850 Coxwell Ave., Toronto, Ontario M4C 5R1
 - via regular mail to: 850 Coxwell Ave., Toronto, Ontario M4C 5R1
 - via email to mlsconditionreporting@toronto.ca; or
 - via fax at 416-392-3102
- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5791, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.
