- 1. Mohammed Ahsan Butt** (Report No. 6075)
Applicant for a Limousine Driver's Licence (Application No. B307667)

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

Mohammed Ahsan Butt's licence will be issued, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of four (4) years to commence on October 24, 2013;
- (2) prior to each of the next four renewals of the licence, Mr. Butt must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
