
TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: October 31, 2013

- 1. Daniel Michael** (Report No. 6094)
Applicant for a Limousine Driver's Licence (Application No. B308364)

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

Daniel Michael's licence will be issued, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Mr. Michael shall provide proof of completion of a defensive driving course approved by the Ministry of Transportation of Ontario, which includes a minimum of two (2) hours in vehicle training, by November 14, 2013 failing which, Mr. Michael's limousine driver's licence shall be suspended until proof of completion is provided;
- (2) immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on October 31, 2013;
- (3) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Michael must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Mr. Michael incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days which can be done in the following ways:
 - in person at 850 Coxwell Ave, Toronto, Ontario M4C 5R1
 - via regular mail to: 850 Coxwell Ave, Toronto, Ontario M4C 5R1
 - via email to mlsconditionreporting@toronto.ca; or
 - via fax at 416-392-3102
- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 6094, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

DECISION:

1710324 Ontario Inc.'s tow truck owner's licences and public garage licence will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) the licences shall be immediately placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on October 31, 2013;
- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licences, Sutheshkumar Sithambarpillay must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if 1710324 Ontario Inc. or Mr. Sithambarpillay incur any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code* or the *Highway Traffic Act*, they must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within five (5) business days which can be done in the following ways:
 - in person at 850 Coxwell Ave, Toronto, Ontario M4C 5R1
 - via regular mail to: 850 Coxwell Ave, Toronto, Ontario M4C 5R1
 - via email to mlsconditionreporting@toronto.ca; or
 - via fax at 416-392-3102
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5718, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.
- (5) every three months, commencing October 31, 2013, Mr. Sithambarpillay shall provide:
 - a) an up-to-date report from the Ministry of Transportation of Ontario of any and all charges and convictions registered in relation to all vehicles owned by the Corporate applicant; and
 - b) by the end of each calendar month, starting with the month of November 2013, detailed mechanical inspection reports prepared by a licensed mechanic for every tow truck licensed to the Corporation.
