
TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: November 14, 2013
Summary of Decisions

1. Richard Edward Daly (Report No. 6066)

Applicant for Renewal of Tow Truck Driver's Licence No. D09-3730637

DECISION:

Richard Edward Daly's tow truck driver's licence will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) the licence shall be immediately suspended for a period of seven (7) days, on November 14, 2013 and Mr. Daly must surrender his tow truck driver's licence and photo card on that date. If for any reason it cannot be provided, an affidavit will be prepared to that effect;
- (2) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of four (4) years to commence on November 14, 2013;
- (3) prior to each of the next four renewals of the licence, Mr. Daly must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, updated abstracts of his criminal and driving records;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Mr. Daly incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code*, the *Criminal Code* or the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days which can be done in the following ways:
 - in person at 850 Coxwell Ave., Toronto, Ontario M4C 5R1
 - via regular mail to: 850 Coxwell Ave., Toronto, Ontario M4C 5R1
 - via email to mlsconditionreporting@toronto.ca; or
 - via fax at 416-392-3102
- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 6066, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing;
- (6) before the next renewal date of February 15, 2014, as a pre-condition to the renewal, Mr. Daly must provide to Municipal

Licensing and Standards proof of payment of all outstanding fines. In the event proof of payment is not provided by February 15, 2014, the licence shall be automatically suspended on that date until they are paid.
