1. Harjap Singh Dehar (Report No. 6105)

Holder of Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-3604145 for Taxicab Plate No. 3210.

DECISION:

The Tribunal adjourned this matter on consent to January 30, 2014, *peremptory* to both parties.

2. Yadwinder Singh Pannu (Report No. 6106)

Holder of Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-3484254 for Taxicab Plate No. 410;
Designated Agent for Plate Nos. 623, 1403 and 3210

DECISION:

The Tribunal adjourned this matter on consent to January 30, 2014, *peremptory* to both parties.

3. Dawit Habte Fikremichael (Report No. 6006)

Applicant for a Taxicab Driver's Licence (Application No. B203535)

DECISION:

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to April 24, 2014.

4. Syed Shaukat Ali (Report No. 6076)

Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3592387

DECISION:

The Tribunal denied the renewal of Syed Shaukat Ali's taxicab driver's licence.

5. Hedi Ovied-Lahouel (Report No. 6037)
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-3132646

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

Hedi Ovied-Lahouel's taxicab owner's licence will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) the licence shall be immediately suspended for a period of five (5) days to commence on November 21, 2013 and Mr. Ovied-Lahouel must surrender his taxicab licence and photo card on that date;
- (2) Mr. Ovied-Lahouel must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards proof of payment of any outstanding fines before November 21, 2013, failing which the licence will be suspended until proof of payment of any outstanding fines is filed;
- (3) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on November 21, 2013;
- (4) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Ovied-Lahouel must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (5) during the probationary period, if Mr. Ovied-Lahouel incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code* or the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days which can be done in the following ways:
 - in person at 850 Coxwell Ave., Toronto, Ontario M4C 5R1
 - via regular mail to: 850 Coxwell Ave., Toronto, Ontario M4C 5R1
 - via email to mlsconditionreporting@toronto.ca; or
 - via fax at 416-392-3102
- (6) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 6037, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

The Tribunal ordered Hedi Ovied-Lahouel to surrender his photo card and licence to Municipal Licensing and Standards immediately.
