
TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: December 12, 2013
Summary of Decisions

1. Mubarak Ali Khan (Report No. 5954)

Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-3242504

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

Mubarak Ali Khan's taxicab owner's licence will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) The licence will be suspended for a period of two (2) days to commence December 12th, 2013 and Mr. Khan must surrender his taxicab licence and photo card on that date;
- (2) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years to commence on December 12, 2013;
- (3) prior to each of the next two renewals of the licence, Mr. Khan must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Mr. Khan incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code* or the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days which can be done in the following ways:

 - via email to mlsconditionreporting@toronto.ca; or
 - via fax at 416-392-3102
- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5954, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution:

Douglas Sedgewick's Tow Truck Driver's Licence will have the following conditions placed on it:

- (1) the licence shall be immediately suspended for a period of five (5) days to commence on December 12, 2013 and Mr. Sedgewick must surrender his tow truck driver's licence and photo card on that date.
- (2) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on December 12, 2013;
- (3) prior to the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Sedgewick must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Mr. Sedgewick incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code* or the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three business days which can be done in the

following ways:

- (3) during the probationary period, if 2248839 Ontario Inc. or Mr. Ma incur any new charges or convictions under the *Criminal Code* or the *Liquor Licence Act*, the corporation must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards in writing, within three (3) business days which can be done in the following ways:
