
TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: December 19, 2013

- 1. 1874025 Ontario Ltd.** (Report No. 6073)
o/a Lakeside Bar & Grill
David Quay Tu, President
Holder of Eating Establishment Licence No. B71-4297746

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following proposed resolution, as amended:

1874025 Ontario Ltd.'s eating establishment licence will have the following conditions placed on it, effective immediately:

- (1) the licence shall be suspended for a period of five (5) days to commence on January 6, 2014 to January 10, 2014 and the licensee must surrender his eating establishment licence on January 6, 2014.
- (2) the licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years to commence on December 19, 2013;
- (3) during the probationary period, no new patrons will be allowed entry to the premises on Sunday, Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday after 1:00 a.m.;
- (4) 1874025 Ontario Ltd. (David Tu, President) will have a security staff member on site to ensure that patrons are not disorderly inside or outside the area and are not creating a disturbance. A security staff member will be on site permanently on the following days: Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays from 10:00 p.m. to closing commencing on December 27, 2013. In addition, a security staff member is to be on site on New Year's Eve, December 31, 2013.

Security staff are to be licensed under the *Private Security and Investigative Services Act* in the Province of Ontario.

- (5) during the probationary period, if 1874025 Ontario Ltd. incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code*, the *Liquor Licence Act*, the *Fire Marshall's Act*, the *Criminal Code* or the *Alcohol and Gaming Regulation and Public Protection Act*, it must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days which can be done in the following ways:

(7) the parties have also agreed that the establishment will be closed on December 23rd, 24th, 25th and 26th.

2. Innocent Prince-Chigozie Okeke (Report No. 6055)

Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3354960

DECISION:

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to February 13, 2014, in order to allow Mr. Okeke to seek representation and ordered that Mr. Okeke's licence be suspended in the interim. If Mr. Okeke wishes to bring the matter back on an earlier date, he may contact Tribunal staff who will facilitate his request.

Mr. Perreault's tow truck driver's licence will be issued, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:
