
TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: February 13, 2014
Summary of Decisions

1. Bashar Kazi (Report No. 6038)

Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3618347

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following jointly proposed resolution:

Bashar Kazi's taxicab driver's licence will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years to commence on February 13, 2014;
- (2) prior to each of the next two renewals of the licence, Mr. Kazi must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Kazi incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code* or the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days which can be done in the following ways:

- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 6038, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3354960

DECISION:

3. Kirkland Deasley (Report No. 6168)
Applicant for a Tow Truck Driver's Licence (Application No. B316177)

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following jointly proposed resolution:

Kirkland Deasley's tow truck driver's licence will be issued, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on February 13, 2014;
- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Deasley must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, updated abstracts of his driving record and criminal record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Deasley incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code* or the *Criminal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days which can be done in the following ways:

Applicant for a Tow Truck Driver's Licence (Application No. B313036)

DECISION:

- 5. Henry Imadojemo** (Report No. 6125)
Holder of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3105160

DECISION:

- 6. John Chijioke Ikwugbado** (Report No. 5987)
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3614310

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following jointly proposed resolution:

John Chijioke Ikwugbado's taxicab driver's licence will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) the licence shall be immediately suspended for a period of four (4) days to commence on February 14, 2014 and the Applicant must surrender his taxicab driver's licence and photo card on that date;
- (2) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on February 13, 2014;
- (3) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Ikwugbado must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, updated abstracts of his driving record and criminal record;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Mr. Ikwugbado incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code*, the *Highway Traffic Act* or the *Criminal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days which can be done in the following ways:

(5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5987, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

The Tribunal ordered Mr. Ikwugbado to surrender his licence and photo card to Municipal Licensing and Standards on Friday morning, February 14, 2014 and advised that he can pick up his documents at the same time on Tuesday, February 18, 2014.

7. Adam Jarman (Report No. 6160)
Applicant for a Tow Truck Driver's Licence (Application No. B316304)

DECISION:

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to March 13, 2014.

(Mr. Jarman failed to attend today's hearing).
