BY-LAW -2017

To provide for a site specific exemption from City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 415, Development of Land, Article III, Conveyance of Land for Parks Purposes, as a condition of development for the property located at 3415-3499 Weston Road.

Whereas Municipal Code Chapter 415, Development of Land, Article III, Conveyance of Land for Parks Purposes as a Condition of Development, §25A provides for the allocation of cash-inlieu of parkland funds; and

Whereas City Council has authorized a site specific exemption for the property located at 3415-3499 Weston Road to provide that despite Municipal Code Chapter 415, Article III, § 25A, all of the cash-in-lieu of parkland funds generated from the development at 3415-3499 Weston Road, shall be allocated to the construction of certain facilities within the district where the funds were generated;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Despite Municipal Code Chapter 415, Development of Land, Article III, Conveyance of Land for Parks Purposes as a Condition of Development, § 25A, all of the cash-in-lieu of parkland funds generated from the development at 3415-3499 Weston Road shall be allocated to the construction of the First Nations Park and path(s) through the abutting hydro corridor to Emery Village Collegiate Institute.
