BY-LAW -2018

To repeal By-laws 1177-2009 and 1178-2009.

Whereas the Municipal Elections Act, 1996 has been amended to prohibit corporate and union contributions to candidates in municipal elections and to authorize the City Clerk to provide for electronic filing and corresponding conditions and limits with respect to electronic filing; and

Whereas the City's groundbreaking prohibition on corporate and union contributions to candidates and its current By-law on electronic filing are no longer required as a result of the amendments to the Municipal Elections Act, 1996;
