**Bill 1467**

**BY-LAW - 2019**

**To expropriate lands for municipal purposes, including the construction of a public lane near 8 Cumberland Street.**

Whereas in accordance with the Expropriations Act, an application was submitted to City Council as Approving Authority for approval to expropriate the land described below, Notice was published and served on the registered owners, no request for inquiry received; and

Whereas the Council of the City of Toronto recommends approval of the expropriation;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. The expropriation of a fee simple interest in the land legally described as:

Part of Lot 21, Concession 2, From the Bay, Township of York, Part 2 on Plan 63R-686, City of Toronto, designated as Part 1 on 66R-30919, being all of PIN 21197-0156(R)

for municipal purposes including the construction of a public lane, is approved by the Council of the City of Toronto as Approving Authority, and authority is granted for the signing, sealing and registration of a Certificate of Approval.

2. The expropriation of a fee simple interest in the land legally described as:

Part of Lot 21, Concession 2, From the Bay, Township of York, Part 2 on Plan 63R-686, City of Toronto, designated as Part 1 on 66R-30919, being all of PIN 21197-0156(R)

for municipal purposes including the construction of a public lane, is authorized by the City of Toronto as Expropriating Authority, and authority is granted for the signing, sealing and registration of an expropriation plan.

3. The Deputy City Manager, Corporate Services and the Director of Real Estate Services, are authorized to sign and effect service of the Notices of Expropriation, Notices of Election, and Notices of Possession, as contemplated by the Expropriations Act, and are authorized and directed to execute all documents and do all things necessary to give effect to this by-law.
