BY-LAW -2020

To amend Municipal Code Chapter 19, Business Improvement Areas, to reflect the expanded boundaries of the Bloor-Yorkville Business Improvement Area.

Whereas the City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 19, Business Improvement Areas designates various areas of the City as Business Improvement Areas, including the Bloor-Yorkville Business Improvement Area; and

Whereas by the enactment of By-law (Insert expansion designation by-law #) on June 29, 2020 (Amend date if necessary), City Council designated an area that includes the existing area of the Bloor-Yorkville Business Improvement Area (as described in By-law 670-2009) as an improvement area; and

Whereas Schedule A of Chapter 19, Business Improvement Areas, must be amended to reflect the designation of the expanded area of the Bloor-Yorkville Business Improvement Area:

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- 1. The Municipal Code Chapter 19, Business Improvement Areas, is amended as follows:
 - A. The table in Schedule A of Municipal Code, Chapter, 19 Business Improvement Areas, is amended by deleting By-law "670-2009" beside the name "Bloor-Yorkville" in the "Designating By-law (Former Municipality)" column and substituting "(Insert expansion designation by-law #)"; and
 - B. Schedule A, Maps is amended by deleting the maps of the Bloor-Yorkville Business Improvement Area and substituting the maps of the Bloor-Yorkville Business Improvement Area attached to this by-law.
