**CITY OF TORONTO**

**Bill 779**

**BY-LAW -2020**

**To technically amend Zoning By-law 569-2013, as amended, with respect to the condition for retail store uses in combination with manufacturing uses in the Employment Industrial Office zone.**

Whereas City Council has delegated to the City Solicitor, in consultation with the City Clerk, by Section 169-5.2B of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 169, Officials, City, the authority to submit bills directly to Council to correct technical errors; and

Whereas Council of the City of Toronto has the authority pursuant to Section 34 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended, to pass this By-law; and

Whereas Council of the City of Toronto has provided adequate information to the public and has held at least one public meeting in accordance with the Planning Act;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. By-law 569-2013, as amended, is further amended as follows:

- (A) Amend Regulation 60.40.20.100(23) by replacing "In the EO zone, a **retail store**:" with "In the EO zone, a **retail store on a lot with a manufacturing use**:"
