To amend former City of North York Zoning By-law 7625, as amended, to remove the holding symbol (H) with respect to the lands known municipally in the year 2019 as 57, 59, and 60 Mobile Drive and 30 Old Eglinton Avenue.

Whereas authority is given to Council by Section 34 and Section 36 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, to impose the holding symbol (H) and to remove the holding symbol (H) when Council is satisfied that the conditions relating to the holding symbol have been satisfied; and

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:


