BY-LAW -2022

To amend By-law 918-2021, being a by-law "To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting O'Connor Drive", respecting Parkside Drive.

Whereas City of Toronto Council on November 9, 10 and 12, 2021 adopted Item MM37.1;

Whereas City of Toronto Council, pursuant to the authority of MM37.1, on November 12, 2021 enacted By-law 918-2021, being a by-law "To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting O'Connor Drive", which title incorrectly referenced "O'Connor Drive" instead of "Parkside Drive";

Whereas pursuant to Section 169-5.2B of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 169, Officials, City, the City Solicitor, in consultation with the City Clerk, may submit bills directly to Council to make technical amendments to the Municipal Code and other by-laws to correct technical errors, to update the by-laws to refer to the current statute, City official title, administrative unit and Municipal Code provision and to repeal by-laws of the former municipalities that have been superseded by provisions in the Municipal Code or as a result of an administrative reorganization;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. The title of By-Law 918-2021 is amended by deleting "O'Connor Drive" and replacing it with "Parkside Drive".
