Bill 256

BY-LAW -2022

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes and Cycle Tracks, respecting George Street South and The Esplanade.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes, and Cycle Tracks, is amended as follows:

- A. By deleting from Schedule E (Cycle Tracks) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

| (From Column 1 Highway) | (From Column 2 Between) | (From Column 3 Lanes) | (From Column 4 Times or Days) |
|-------------------------|--|--|-------------------------------|
| The Esplanade | Lower Jarvis Street to a point 20 metres west of Lower Sherbourne Street | Southerly Eastbound | Anytime |
| The Esplanade | Lower Jarvis Street to Lower Sherbourne Street | Southerly westbound lane adjacent to the southerly eastbound cycle track | Anytime |

- B. By inserting in Schedule E (Cycle Tracks) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

| (In Column 1 Highway) | (In Column 2 Between) | (In Column 3 Lanes) | (In Column 4 Times or Days) |
|-----------------------|--|--|-----------------------------|
| The Esplanade | George Street South to a point 20 metres west of Lower Sherbourne Street | Southerly Eastbound | Anytime |
| The Esplanade | George Street South to Lower Sherbourne Street | Southerly westbound lane adjacent to the southerly eastbound cycle track | Anytime |
