**Bill 260**

**BY-LAW -2022**

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, respecting Lindsey Avenue.**

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule II (Designated On-Street Parking for Permit Holders), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	In Column 4 Time or Days)
Lindsey Avenue	North	A point 44 metres east of Gladstone Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further east	Anytime from the 16th day to the last day of each month from Apr. 1 to Nov. 30, inclusive
Lindsey Avenue	South	A point 49 metres east of Gladstone Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further east	Anytime from Dec. 1 of one year to Mar. 31 of the next following year, inclusive and from the 1st day to the 15th day of each month from Apr. 1 to Nov. 30, inclusive

B. By inserting in Schedule II (Designated On-Street parking for Permit Holders), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Time or Days)
Lindsey Avenue	South	A point 68.5 metres east of Brock Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further east	Anytime

- C. By deleting from Schedule III (Designated On-Street Loading Zones for Permit Holders), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	In Column 4 Time or Days)
Lindsey Avenue	North	A point 20.5 metres east of Gladstone Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further east	Anytime

- D. By inserting in Schedule III (Designated On-Street Loading Zones for Permit Holders), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Time or Days)
Lindsey Avenue	West	A point 15 metres north of Bloor Street West and a point 25 metres further north	Anytime
