## BY-LAW -2022

- A. By inserting in Schedule D (Designated Lanes for Bicycles) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

Tecumseth Street	Queen Street West and a point 37 metres south	Easterly Northbound	Anytime
Tecumseth Street	King Street West and Tecumseth Place (north leg)	Easterly Northbound	Anytime
Tecumseth Street	Queen Street West and a point 37m south	Westerly Southbound	Anytime
