Bill 371

BY-LAW -2022

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, respecting Robinson Avenue.

Whereas Scarborough Community Council on September 17, 2021 adopted Item SC26.16, wherein the report (August 23, 2021) from the Acting Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services recommended the designation of an on-street accessible parking space on Robinson Avenue;

Whereas Scarborough Community Council at its meeting on September 17, 2021 enacted By-law 760-2021, being a by-law "To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, respecting Robinson Avenue." wherein the entry for Robinson Avenue was deleted from instead of inserted into Schedule II, Designated On-street Parking for Permit Holders, of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons With Disabilities;

Whereas there was no such entry to delete from Schedule II, Designated On-street Parking for Permit Holders, of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons With Disabilities;

Whereas Section 169-5.2A of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 169, Officials, City, authorizes the City Solicitor to process by-laws where an action is authorized by Council and if the recommendation to amend a by-law or introduce a bill has been omitted or if there is an error in the reference to the by-law that should be amended or if it is necessary to repeal a by-law;

Whereas pursuant to Section 169-5.2B of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 169, Officials, City, the City Solicitor, in consultation with the City Clerk, may submit bills directly to Council to make technical amendments to the Municipal Code and other by-laws to correct technical errors, to update the by-laws to refer to the current statute, City official title, administrative unit and Municipal Code provision and to repeal by-laws of the former municipalities that have been superseded by provisions in the Municipal Code or as a result of an administrative reorganization;

The Scarborough Community Council enacts:

1. By-law 760-2021 is repealed.
2. Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, is amended as follows:

- A. By inserting in Schedule II (Designated On-Street Parking for Permit Holders), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Time or Days)
Robinson Avenue	East	A point 36 metres south of Newport Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further south	Anytime
