**Bill 390**

**BY-LAW -2022**

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Dupont Street.**

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Dupont Street	North	Ossington Avenue and Shaw Street	Anytime

B. By inserting in Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Dupont Street	North	Ossington Avenue and a point 144 metres west of Shaw Street	Anytime

C. By deleting from Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Dupont Street	North	A point 36 metres east of Lansdowne Avenue and a point 48 metres east of Palmerston Avenue	4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri. except public holidays

D. By inserting in Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:
