BY-LAW -2022

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Don Roadway, Saulter Street South and Villiers Street.

- A. By deleting from Schedule XIX (One-Way Traffic Lanes) in § 950-1318, the following in alphabetical order by street name:
