BY-LAW -2022

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- 1. By-law 548-2022 is amended by deleting the following from ss. 1(3):
 - (oo) 1,012 sq. ft. at 224 Augusta Avenue, as further described as Assessment Roll Number 1904-06-5-650-02100-0000-04;
- 2. This By-law is deemed to have come into force on July 12, 2022.
