**Bill 996**

**BY-LAW -2022**

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes and Cycle Tracks, respecting Cherry Street and Commissioners Street.**

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes, and Cycle Tracks, is amended as follows:

- A. By inserting in Schedule D (Designated Lanes for Bicycles) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Lanes)	(In Column 4 Times or Days)
Cherry Street	A point 23 metres south of Polson Street and a point 104 metres further south	Westerly Northbound and Southbound	Anytime

- B. By inserting in Schedule E (Cycle Tracks) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Lanes)	(In Column 4 Times or Days)
Commissioners Street	Cherry Street (west intersection) and a point 30 metres east of Cherry Street (east intersection)	Northerly Westbound	Anytime
Commissioners Street	Cherry Street (west intersection) and a point 30 metres east of Cherry Street (east intersection)	Southerly Eastbound	Anytime

2. Section 1 of this By-law shall take effect on the date that section 1 of By-law \*\*\*\* -2022, is in effect.
