BY-LAW -2022

To appoint Will Johnston as an Interim Deputy City Manager.

Whereas under section 140 of the City of Toronto Act, 2006, the City may appoint a chief administrative officer; and

Whereas under section 77 of the Legislation Act, the power to appoint a person to a public office includes the power to appoint a deputy; and

Whereas under section 67 of the Legislation Act, words in the singular include the plural; and

Whereas Council has approved an administrative structure in which the City's chief administrative officer is called the "City Manager" and is to be assisted by three Deputy City Managers and a Chief Financial Officer;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- 1. Will Johnston is appointed to the office of Interim Deputy City Manager, Infrastructure and Development Services.
- 2. Will Johnston shall have all the powers conferred and duties of the City Manager under Article I of Chapter 169, Officials, City, of the City of Toronto Municipal Code as may be assigned by the City Manager from time to time.
- 3. This by-law comes into effect on the latter of August 20, 2022 or the date on which Will Johnston has entered into a written employment agreement with the City for the Interim Deputy City Manager, Infrastructure and Development Services position.
