BY-LAW No. 27-1998

A By-law respecting the size of the Board of Health for the City of Toronto Health Unit and the term of office of Board members.

WHEREAS, by the City of Toronto Act, 1997 (No. 2), a board of health for the City of Toronto (the "Board of Health") was established on January 1, 1998, under the name of Board of Health for the City of Toronto Health Unit in English and Conseil de Santé de la circonscription sanitaire de la cité de Toronto in French;

AND WHEREAS subsection 46(2) of the City of Toronto Act, 1997 (No. 2) provides that the Council of the City shall, by by-law, establish the size of the Board of Health in accordance with subsection 49(2) of the Health Protection and Promotion Act;

AND WHEREAS subsection 49(2) of the Health Protection and Promotion Act provides that there shall not be fewer than three (3) and not more than thirteen (13) municipal members of each board of health;

The Council of The City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- **1.** In this by-law,
 - (a) "Council" means the Council of the City of Toronto;
 - (b) "Municipal Member" means a person appointed to the Board of Health by Council.
- 2. The Board of Health shall consist of ten (10) Municipal Members.

3. The term of office of a Municipal Member continues during the pleasure of Council that appointed the Municipal Member but, unless ended sooner, ends with the ending of the term of office of the Council.
