**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 34-1998**

**To appoint and delineate certain duties and responsibilities of the  
Commissioner responsible for works and emergency services.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Barry Hugh Gutteridge is hereby appointed Commissioner responsible for works and emergency services (the "Commissioner") for a term expiring 3 years from the date this by-law comes into force.
2. The Commissioner shall be responsible for the direction and control of all departmental and organizational units responsible for providing works and emergency services.
3. The Commissioner shall carry out such additional duties and exercise such additional responsibilities as Council may from time to time prescribe.
4. Where this by-law conflicts with the provisions of any other by-law setting out the powers and duties of a municipal official, this by-law prevails to the extent of the conflict.
5. Paragraph A of Section 1 of By-law No. 1996-0234, being a by-law "To appoint Thomas R. Greer, Barry H. Gutteridge, John D. Morand and Margaret Rodrigues as Commissioners and jointly as the City's Chief Administrative Officer (called the 'Board of Management')" enacted by the council of the former City of Toronto is repealed.
6. This by-law shall come into force on the date of its enactment.
