BY-LAW No. 35-1998

**To appoint and delineate certain duties and responsibilities of the
Commissioner responsible for planning and urban development.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Virginia West is hereby appointed Commissioner responsible for planning and urban development services (the "Commissioner") for a term expiring 3 years from the date this by-law comes into force.
2. The Commissioner shall be responsible for the direction and control of all departmental and organizational units responsible for providing planning and urban development services.
3. The Commissioner shall carry out such additional duties and exercise such additional responsibilities as Council may from time to time prescribe.
4. Where this by-law conflicts with the provisions of any other by-law setting out the powers and duties of a municipal official, this by-law prevails to the extent of the conflict.
5. Section 2, as amended, of By-law No. 82-94 being a by-law "To appoint a Chief Administrative Officer for the Corporation of the Borough of East York and to define her duties" as enacted by the council of the former Borough of East York is repealed.
6. This by-law shall come into force on the date of its enactment.
