CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 36-1998

To appoint and delineate certain duties and responsibilities of the Commissioner responsible for community and neighbourhood services.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1.** Shirley Hoy is hereby appointed Commissioner responsible for community and neighbourhood services (the "Commissioner") for a term expiring 3 years from the date this by-law comes into force.
- 2.** The Commissioner shall be responsible for the direction and control of all departmental and organizational units responsible for providing community and neighbourhood services.
- 3.** The Commissioner shall carry out such additional duties and exercise such additional responsibilities as Council may from time to time prescribe.
- 4.** Where this by-law conflicts with the provisions of any other by-law setting out the powers and duties of a municipal official, this by-law prevails to the extent of the conflict.
- 5.** By-law No. 10-96, being a by-law "To appoint a Commissioner of Community Services for The Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto" and By-law No. 173-96, being a by-law "To appoint an Acting Chief Administrative Officer for The Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto" enacted by the council of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto are repealed.
- 6.** This by-law shall come into force on the date of its enactment.
