BY-LAW No. 65-1998

A By-law to provide for the temporary closing to vehicular and pedestrian traffic on Harlandale Avenue for the purpose of construction of the Sheppard Subway, Harlandale Avenue emergency ventilation shaft.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. That Harlandale Avenue, as shown on the plan attached hereto as Schedule "A", be and the same is temporarily closed from Beecroft Road to a point 25 metres west of Yonge Street, from January 21, 1998, to June 1, 1998, for the purpose of subway construction.
- **2.** During the time of the temporary closure, there shall be no use except under the authority of a permit issued by the Commissioner of Transportation.
