**BY-LAW No. 70-1998**

**A By-law to amend City of North York By-law 30901, as amended.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

**1.** That Schedule "A" of City of North York By-law 30901, as amended, be and the same is hereby further amended by adding to the columns MUNICIPAL ADDRESS - DEVIATION PERMITTED - CONDITIONS, the following:

<u>MUNICIPAL ADDRESS</u>	<u>DEVIATION PERMITTED</u>	<u>CONDITIONS</u>
134 Groton Street in the Community of North York.	The wrought iron and sheet metal fence located along the south property line may be maintained on the property as constructed.	Any landscaping located along the south property line and within 2.40m (8 feet) of the front lot line not exceed a height of 0.76m (30 inches).  The fence be maintained in compliance with the fence by-law in all other respects.
