BY-LAW No. 71-1998

A By-law to amend City of North York By-law 30901, as amended.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. That Schedule "A" of City of North York By-law 30901, as amended, be and the same is hereby further amended by adding to the columns MUNICIPAL ADDRESS - DEVIATION PERMITTED - CONDITIONS, the following:

30 Florida Crescent in the Community of North York.	The chain link fence located along the north and west property lines may be maintained with 5.08m (2 inch) wire mesh.	<p>The fence be maintained in compliance with the fence by-law in all other respects.</p> <p>Any gaps in the cedar hedge which acts to screen the chain link fence be planted with new cedar hedging.</p> <p>The cedar hedge be maintained in a healthy growing condition.</p>
