**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 110-1998**

**To appoint Dr. Sheela Basrur as Medical Officer of Health for the  
City of Toronto Health Unit and to repeal By-law No. 16-1998  
respecting the Acting Medical Officer of Health.**

WHEREAS City Council at its meeting held January 2, 6, 8 and 9, 1998 appointed Dr. Sheela Basrur as Acting Medical Officer of Health for the City of Toronto Health Unit; and

WHEREAS the function of appointing the Medical Officer of Health is delegated to City Council pursuant to the City of Toronto Act, 1997 (No. 2); and

WHEREAS the Health Protection and Promotion Act provides that no person is eligible for appointment as a Medical Officer of Health unless the Minister of Health approves the proposed appointment;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1.** Dr. Sheela Basrur is appointed Medical Officer of Health for the City of Toronto Health Unit.
- 2.** By-law No. 16-1998 being a by-law "To delineate certain duties and responsibilities of the Acting Medical Officer of Health" is repealed.
- 3.** This by-law comes into force upon approval of this appointment by the Minister of Health under clause 64(c) of the Health Protection and Promotion Act;
