## BY-LAW No. 112-1998

To acquire all rights, title and interests in the private land located at the rear of premises Nos. 6 - 16 St. James Court for public lane purposes.

In the City of Toronto and Province of Ontario, being composed of part of Lot 16 in Concession 1 From the Bay in the geographic Township of York designated as PARTS 7 to 12, inclusive, on Plan 63R-2150 deposited in the Land Registry Office for the Metropolitan Toronto Registry Division (No. 64).
