**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 122-1998**

**To dedicate certain lands on Bloor Street West for  
the purposes of a public highway.**

WHEREAS the lands hereinafter described have been acquired by the City of Toronto for highway purposes.

Now, therefore, the Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The lands described in Schedule "A", hereto attached are hereby dedicated as a public highway and declared to form part of Bloor Street West.
2. The said Schedule "A", hereto attached, shall form part of this By-law.
